Teaching is delivered mostly online in an asynchronous format. Online learning will be supported by a number of face-to-face workshops and masterclasses each semester (which will also be recorded). The programme is offered on a part-time basis over 2 years, providing maximum flexibility, and allowing students to combine programme with full-time work.

Who Should Apply?

The programme will, in particular, be of use and interest to those already working in the field of law, including barristers, solicitors and civil servants who want to upskill in the area of international law and those with an NGO background who want to expand their knowledge of international law.

Applications are welcome from candidates with a minimum 2.2 honours degree in law or cognate disciplines, though applications from other candidates with prior experiential learning may be considered.
